Aim of the non-inspection activity: Improved occupational safety situation in technology classes in basic schools and vocational schools

Scope of the non-inspection activity (description): All basic schools and VOCOs in Estonia Sector covered by the non-inspection activity: education (Schools and VOCOs)

The number of establishments covered by the non-inspection activity: **560 basic schools ;23 VOCOs** The number of specialised staff (but not labour inspectors) involved in implementing the non-inspection activity: **1**

The number of persons involved in supervising the implementation of the non-inspection activity (including the preparation of communication and promotional materials and summing up its results): 2 (there are two working environment consultants in Labour Inspectorate were involved with this activity)

Background of the non-inspection activity: After acknowledging that the occupational safety and health situation in schools and technology classes of vocational schools is poor, the Labour Inspectorate issued a handbook for them entitled "Working Environment Handbook" (https://ti.ee/media/1057/download; https://ti.ee/media/1058/download), made a thematic day to introduce the book (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=j6jrtPjDGD8) and prepared a letter of formal notice for all basic schools and vocational schools. After that, the school principals were able to invite a working environment consultant to the school, who advised the school manager and technology class teacher on how to improve the safety situation in the class.

Budget of the non-inspection activity: issuing the handbook: 7800 EUR

Short summary of the outcome of the non-inspection activity: Following the outreach activities (62 people participated in the presentation of the Working Environment Handbook), the working environment consultant was invited to the schools 13 times. A targeted inspection was also planned for the following years.
